1st Grade Summer Work and Supply List

Math: All scholars are responsible for logging into IXL and completing 15 minutes of math each week. Practicing on IXL will keep the scholars' math skills strong over the summer. Scholars should also practice counting to 100, and review their addition/subtraction facts within 10.

Reading: Scholars must make time for reading every day. The summer is a great time to explore your local library and foster a love of reading in your child. Have your child pick out books that interest them and read them together several times. Before reading, look at the cover and talk about what might be inside. As you read, encourage your child to read words or letter sounds that they recognize. After reading, ask your child if they can tell you what happened at the beginning, middle, and end of the story. The following authors have written numerous books that first graders enjoy: Eric Carle, Bill Martin Jr., Kevin Henkes, Arnold Lobel, Tomie dePaola, Cynthia Rylant.

Scholars should also make sure to review kindergarten tricky words (sight words)
